Job Posting: Mental Health Counselor

The Social Learning Center, LLC is a private counseling practice located in Cheshire, CT, that is looking to grow its therapeutic staff. We are in search of a dynamic, innovative clinician who is eager to make a difference in the lives of individuals who may be struggling with social or mental health barriers.

Our director, Dr. Chris Abildgaard, is a nationally recognized speaker and expert in the field of developmental disabilities who is excited about bringing on some new clinical talent to help our growing clientele. We are seeking a Master's level Mental Health Clinician who has experience working with individuals ages 5 and older who present with a variety of developmental disabilities and other mental health conditions.

Supervision towards Professional Counseling licensure can be provided for those who hold an LPC-A. Please check out our website, www.sociallearningcenter.org to learn more about our approach, our current staff, and our philosophy.

Requirements:

- ❖ Master's in Mental Health Counseling or a Related Field.
- ❖ Must hold a minimum of an associate's license (LPC-A, LMSW) . Clinicians are financially responsible for keeping their associate's or professional license up to date and completing their required hours of CE's per year.
- ❖ Experience working with individuals with developmental disabilities and other childhood mental health disorders.

Job Description:

Mental Health Clinician Duties can include but are not limited to:

- Providing individual counseling services
- Responsibilities for all client notes / other clinical paperwork needed and reviewing them with their supervisor at the time of supervision.
- Meeting with the lead clinician for up to 1 hour per week at a time that is scheduled between both parties. Those with LPC-A can use these as supervision hours toward professional licensure.
- When appropriate, the clinician will lead social cognitive groups and be responsible for all duties associated with running social cognitive groups (contact with parents, helping to schedule, lesson planning, providing feedback to families, etc.).

Hours:

- We are looking for a full time counselor. 37.5 hours are expected with 28-30 hours being direct client contact. 7.5 hours will be allowed for staff meetings, supervision and general office duties to help support clients.
- Most clients are seen after school; 2-7/8pm, Mon-Thurs and 3-5pm on Fridays.

Rate of Compensation & Benefits:

- Compensation will be salary based and in accordance with one's level of experience.
