
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SLC Summer Groups 2024

Growing Social Groups

Playgroup 1 - Morning Group

Description: For our youngest social learners, this group will be centered around developing and strengthening social/emotional skills through social narratives and purposeful play. School Aged Groups

Movie Time Social Learning (Elementary Group)

Description: When we are in face-to-face interactions, there is no pause, rewind, or replay buttons. But in Movie Time Social Learning, there are! One of the greatest challenges in how to think socially is finding interesting, imaginative, and enjoyable ways for students of all ages to study complex social situations. This method of examining and improving social competencies utilizes an activity many students already love—watching stories on our screens, whether movies, TV shows or YouTube clips—and uses them as a springboard to study how we make sense of people in context. The movies will depict more complex social interaction characters that show various emotional regulation skills, and highlight social problem solving in the moment. The list of movies/shows will be predetermined by Dr. Chris. This 1.5 hour summer session will be better suited for individuals who are working on more advanced levels.

Debugging the Social Code

Description: This group is a beginner's journey into coding! Group members will be introduced to a block-based coding language that provides an easy and fun starting point into coding using popular animations and games! This group will focus on helping clients explore and practice flexible thinking, teamwork, creativity, social skills, and executive functioning through learning important coding concepts and hands-on activities.

School Aged Groups Social Coders

Description: Calling all Social Coders! This group is for our intermediate level Social Coders who are looking to expand their knowledge of coding fundamentals. Group members should have knowledge and previous experience with block-based coding and programming concepts, such as basic algorithms, debugging code, events, loops, and conditionals! This group will introduce clients how to transfer their knowledge to the coding language, Python, while focusing on helping clients practice flexible thinking, teamwork, executive functioning skills, and problem solving.


Description: Middle school can be a challenging time for any individual. Those with neurodiverse learning styles often struggle with picking up on those social norms as they relate to creating positive and healthy relationships and balancing those executive function requirements to function within the social and academic environment. This group will focus on helping clients pick up on those social and EF norms and strategies to use then feeling overwhelmed, confused or socially isolated. An emphasis will be placed on social and communication problem solving abilities with adults and peers of the same age.

High School & Adult Groups

High School Girls Group

Description: This group will provide those that identify as female a safe place to focus on both the social and emotional world of living in the high school world. The goal of this is to create an environment for these individuals to grow more comfortable sharing space with others and initiate/engage in conversation with those of their own age. Various themes will be embedded such as self-image, resiliency, advocacy, and building/maintaining healthy connections.



Adulting in 2024

Description: Our Young Adult groups have been an amazing experience for us here at the SLC and we are excited to run a group this summer! This 6 week non-gender specific group is as much about creating same-aged social connections as it is about discussing current issues young adults have when navigating the social world. This group will be addressing concepts relating to work, taking responsibility, social media and online relationships, friendships and romantic relationships, and just what it means to "adult" in today's world. This summer there will be an emphasis on helping participants understand those "hard and soft skills" needed to be successful in today's world.
